INSTRUCTIONS:

Here's how it works!

Katie Duffin was diagnosed at the age of 6 months with PNET (Primitive Neural Ecto Dermal Tumor), a cancerous golf-ball sized tumor located under her left shoulder. Katie underwent surgery, chemotherapy treatments, then, more surgery. Katie responded to treatment, and did well until March 11, 2003 (almost 4 years to the day from the original diagnosis). A routine MRI revealed that the tumor had returned, and now had "fingers" growing from it. Surgery, chemotherapy, and radiation, unfortunately, were not enough. Katie began having severe headaches, the cancer had found its way into the tissue that surrounds the brain as well as her spine.

On August 12, 2003, eleven days short of her 5th birthday, Katie passed away. The primary goal of Katie's Crusaders is to promote pediatric cancer awareness, and to assist families and children affected by cancer and other childhood diseases.
